#### Current state of EMAP 2



- project period:
  - 1.10.2010 31.8.2012 (extension until 20.9.2012)
- we managed to do: 4 very positively evaluated training seminars for 136 HEI representatives formed in 48 joint programmes consortia
- still in workplan: evaluation of applications submitted, dissemination activities, project management activities

### Grant agreement amendment



- submitted to EACEA, now waiting for result
- reasons:
- 1/ change in work plan (panel session at EAIE in September, more promotion of project results)
- 2/ change of eligibility period (until 20.9.2012)
- 3/ budget transfer among headings of eligible costs that exceed 10% (from "Conferences and seminars" to "Other costs", especially for promotion activities and bank fees)
